MINISTRY OF HOSPITALITY



Last week I mentioned two clerestory windows on the northern wall of the Chancel. One of them is a memorial to Canon Frederick and Mrs Annette McDonnell. Canon McDonnell was a Priest in several parishes in the Diocese including Marulan. He was a canon of St. Saviour's from 1907 until his sudden death in 1923. He was a gifted administrator and was largely responsible for putting the Diocese on a sound financial footing. Canon McDonnell was a driving force in the completion of the Soldiers 'Chapel. He also played a significant role in the first attempt to build the bell tower and spire. Mrs McDonnell was very active in St Saviour's congregation and she lived until 1969. The windows depict an angel in white at the open tomb and they were a gift to the Cathedral from Canon and Mrs McDonnell's daughters. Would members of the team check the roster – a few people have had to cancel and it would be good if others could take their places. Cathedral Week, in conjunction with the Heritage and Roses Festival, is this week and it is important that the Cathedral is open all week. I need some help on Thursday (11th) afternoon and Sunday (14th) afternoon. Thanks in anticipation!
