

1 Peter 2.1-10 Rid yourselves, therefore, of all malice, and all guile, insincerity, envy, and all slander. Like newborn infants, long for the pure, spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow into salvation— if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good. Come to him, a living stone, though rejected by mortals yet chosen and precious in God's sight, and like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. For it stands in scripture: 'See, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious; and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame.' To you then who believe, he is precious; but for those who do not believe, 'The stone that the builders rejected has become the very head of the corner', and 'A stone that makes them stumble, and a rock that makes them fall.' They stumble because they disobey the word, as they were destined to do. But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvellous light. The Gospel of our lord: John 10.1-10

Very truly, I tell you, anyone who does not enter the sheepfold by the gate but climbs in by another way is a thief and a bandit. The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep hear his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice. They will not follow a stranger, but they will run from him because they do not know the voice of strangers.' Jesus used this figure of speech with them, but they did not understand what he was saying to them.

So again Jesus said to them, 'Very truly, I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and bandits; but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters by me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

ABM REFLECTION

Sheep and stones. Selling everything you have and holding all things in common. Today's readings share a thread of the communal, of collectivity, of connection. They are reminders that we are more than individuals, that we are each precious and part of a larger whole at the same time. There is not one stone in the temple that isn't important, but its importance lies in being part of the whole structure. One stone is not a cathedral. One sheep is not a flock. Together we make up the whole, and we make the whole by sharing. Like sheep, like bricks, we are made for being with each other. • Pray that we can allow ourselves to be shepherded, so that we might feel supported and tended. Pray that we can allow ourselves to be hewn, so that we can better support others. • Give thanks for the work and witness of the Hong Kong Sheng Kung Hui, the Anglican Church of Hong Kong.

195121951951951951951951951951951 Canon Anne writes: Our Weekday Eucharists are little gems. They are for you and anyone in the cathedral at the time. Should you not be able to make it to your usual Sunday Service due to other commitments, these two service provide you with your regular spiritual feeding. Three to seven people attend, some one week but not the next, There are no hymns but rather a very short homily and an opportunity to ask a question or not, an explanation is sometimes given as to why we do this or that in our liturgy. It is a gentle time, enjoyed by all. As Jesus called us: "Come and see!: Prayer: prayer has many parts, all of which are important, but none more than intercession. It has a special relevance a we age, especially when we forego active participation in many church activities. Our long experience of life means that we are able to pray with better understanding (we hope!) for the tasks we once did which others now fulfil. As grandparents and great grandparents we can pray for the challenges our children and grandchildren face and we can pray for those who mourn loss of a loved one. Yet we are not just to pray for those who are close to us. As God's concern is for all men and women the world over. Governments and rulers are not to be neglected. There is not a single day when the media doesn't bring matters of urgency such as refugees, people overwhelmed by natural disasters or questionable government policy. 2525252525252525252525

All these prompt us to pray. Similarly, an ambulance or police siren call us to pray for those in danger or those assisting them. We may be ignorant of the details, but God is not.

Derek Prime in his book "A Good Old Age" says that intercession should also be made for those who hold special responsibilities of spiritual leadership. Sometimes decisions or ways of doing things may bother us but that should be grounds for us to pray for the leadership team rather than criticize them. Sadly critical people seldom pray.

Pentecost Luncheon: Last year a luncheon was held at the Workers Club for all and about a third of our parish attended. It was a very pleasant gathering. Now a year later, the Parish Council decided to hold a brunch in the parish hall after the only service of the day at 9am. Sandwiches hot food and sweets for \$15 per head, \$5 for children under 16. We hope the 8am people will attend and get to know new members.
