Each year, this Sunday is set aside for us to ponder on 'The Trinity'. We acknowledge this doctrine throughout the year, especially whenever we say one of the creeds, but too often the words just flash by. On this day, many preachers try to explain The Trinity by use of symbols like triangles and intersecting circles, or examples such as ice, water, steam, or different facets in our own life. But it is still not easy to understand. St Augustine spent decades writing his 15-chapter book, *De Trinitate*, and almost gave up. The theology of the Trinity is a difficult subject to explain or discuss. Indeed, there is no explicit description of the Trinity in the Scriptures at all; the orthodox view of the Trinity (as three persons in one God) is an inferential conclusion from the Bible that took generations to assemble. The best we can do is accept it as a faith doctrine and encompass it in our beliefs.

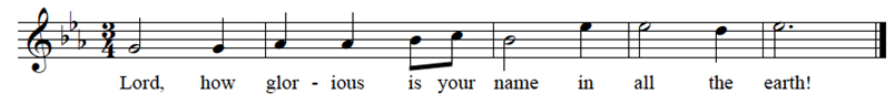
