your blessed hope perceiving.

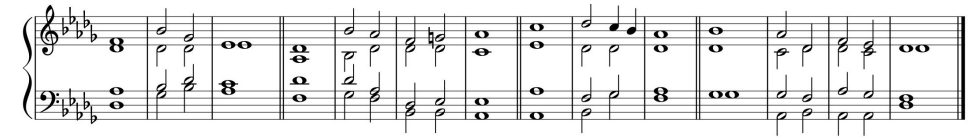
