happy in thy precious love.

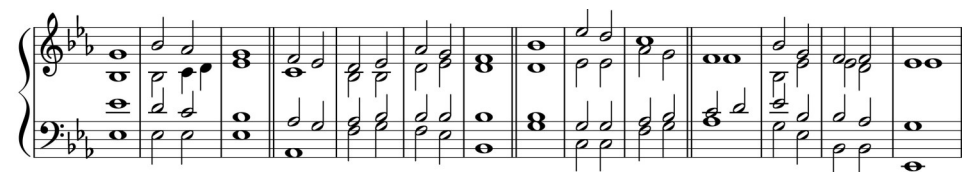
