The Lord has shown strength with his arm: **and scattered the proud in their conceit,**

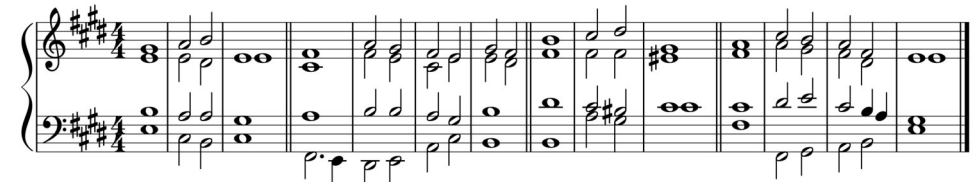
Casting down the mighty from their thrones: **and lifting up the lowly.**
