but ever undefiled remain.

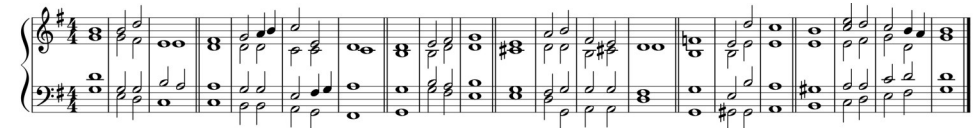
O Christ, I lift my eyes;
