from him that dwells within:

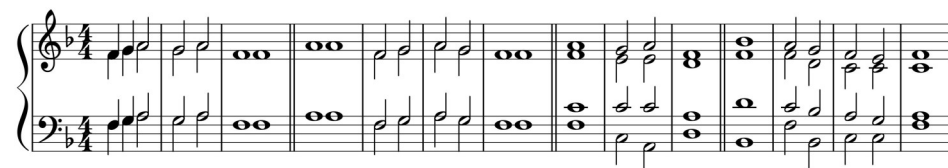
