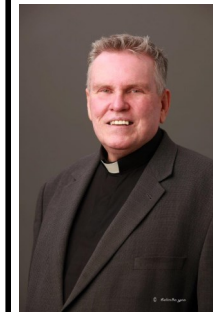

let there be light.

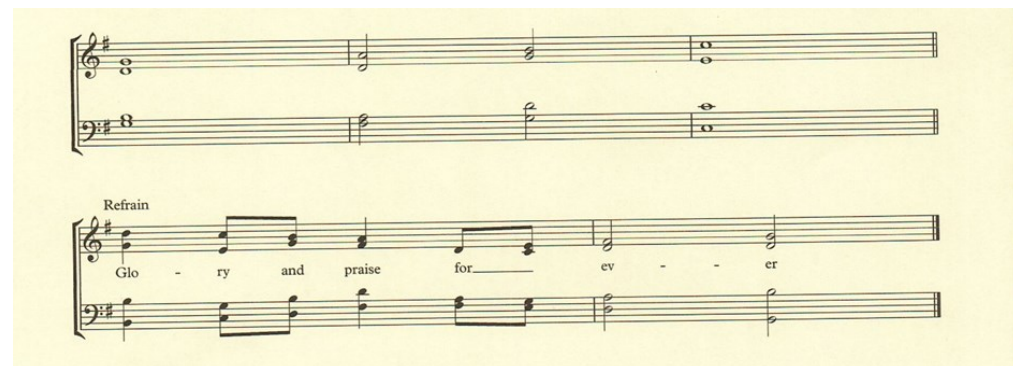
