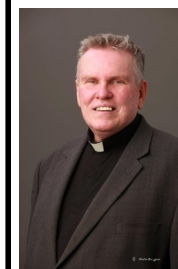

repeat his mercies in your song.

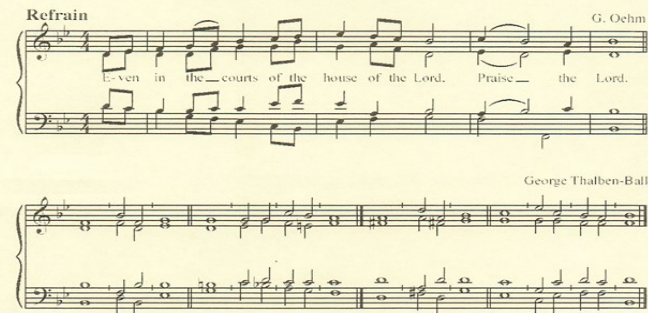
Give to the Lord of lords renown,
