This Lenten season we remember that we are walking that same road home to the father where we are welcomed and forgiven through Christ.

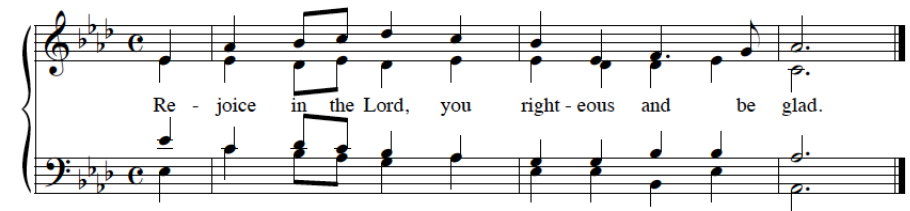

## CATHEDRAL CHILDREN'S MINISTRY of MUSIC

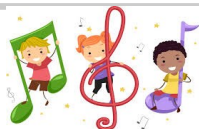
A new ministry aimed at pre-school children with parents.
