more blessings than their father lost.

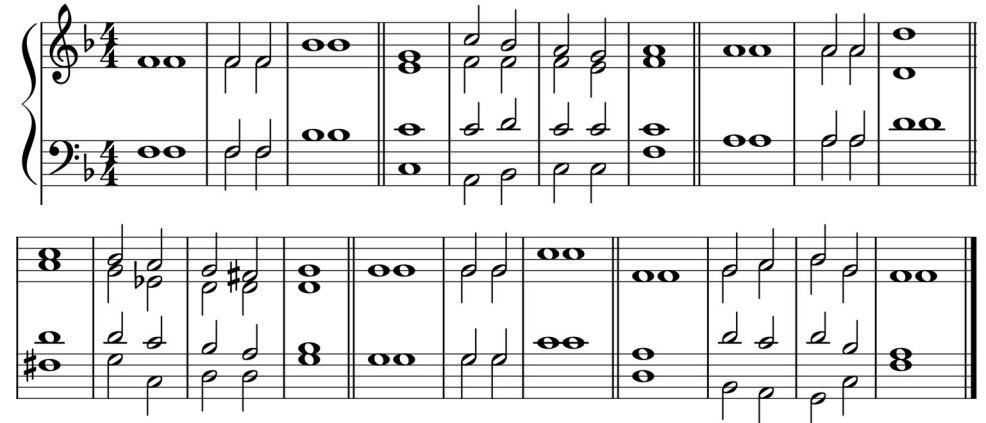
