at one with all in hope and need.

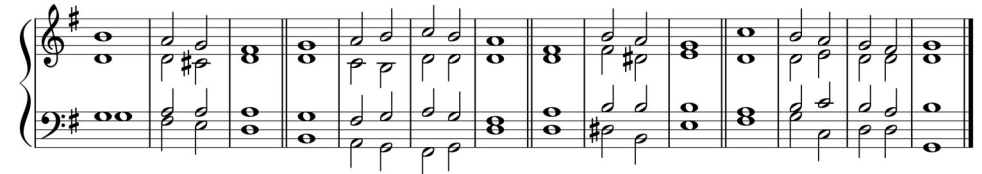
To fill each human house with love,
