*A Happy Organist*

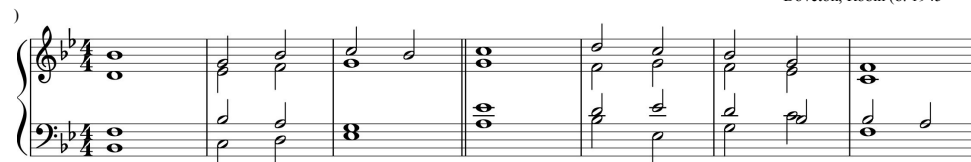
Robert our organist Has reported that he was ecstatically happy last Sunday after our tuner Ian Brown's extended visit. Ian had replaced heavily compacted pedalboard felts that had performed sterling service since Brown & Arkley's major refurbishment 38 years ago! Minutely calculated correct touch (drop) has been dramatically restored, allowing for accurate and comfortable pedalling which has put an end to many intrusive "rumblings" from adjacent keys unavoidably held simultaneously. Robert already feels a significant improvement in pedal technique and accuracy.
